Vendors are required to book the total number of Sales Tables they will require. Display boxes may be stacked two boxes high. Vendor entry for benching from 7:00AM on the 20th May 2018. All birds/product are to be benched No later than 8:45 AM. Doors open to the Public at 9:00AM and sales cease at 12:00PM.

All birds/products cleared from venue no later than 2:00PM.

2018 NON LICENSED BIRD SALE CONDITIONS

1. Birds offered for sale are restricted to the following Schedules of NCR 2006: Exempt Schedule, and Domestic Schedule (non-native birds).2. Strictly no Hybrids, Poultry, Domestic Pigeons. Show (Fancy) Pigeons accepted. No unweaned birds to be offered for sale or to be on display.
2. **All sale cages/boxes are to comply with the standards as listed below:**
 - a. *cages/boxes are to have the three sides, top and bottom, made of a solid material. The front is to be of suitably sized wire. Alternately, a full mesh/barred cage that has the sides, back, top and bottom enclosed with a suitable material eg: MDF sheet may be accepted at the discretion of the Stewards. Any queries please call Annette McGuire. Any birds in a cage/box not meeting these standards will be excluded.*
 - b. *cages/boxes are to contain/have suitable feed and water, sufficient for the duration of the sale. Feeders should be at Perch Height. Overcrowding of birds in cage/boxes is not permitted. Steward's discretion is final. Recommend no more than four birds per cage/box (finches excepted).*The Stewards reserve the right to reject entry or display for sale, any bird considered to be in poor health or condition, or, displayed in any cage/box not considered suitable for sale
3. On arrival, the vendor of native birds is to present their appropriate Permit to Display (if required), to the Stewards. This must be on display at all times. Birds not on the Permit will not be allowed entry.
4. Late registration is at the discretion of the Stewards and may be refused if there is insufficient display space. A late registration Fee of \$10:00 may apply.
5. Vendors are only permitted to have **ONE** assistant during the benching period. **No others will be permitted entry. No Exceptions. All Vendors and their assistant must be members of the Thuringowa bird Club Inc or members of Club Affiliated with The Canary & Cage Bird Federation of Australia Inc. There will be no exceptions to this rule.**
6. The sale of birds outside of the registered sales venue is in breach of NCR 2006 and is therefore strictly prohibited.
7. All vendors are to be aware and conversant with the regulations governing the sale of native birds. Vendors are to advise buyers of their responsibilities accordingly. Guidelines may be downloaded from: https://www.ehp.qld.gov.au/licences-permits/plants-animals/moving-wildlife/moving_native_and_exotic_wildlife.html
8. Suitable escape proof exchange cages will be provided at the venue. Vendors are to use this facility for the safe transfer of birds. Any escapees are to be immediately notified to the Stewards.
9. Vendors are strongly encouraged to issue a receipt or MTR (as applicable) for the sale of any bird (s). This is particularly important for birds on the Exempt and Domestic Schedule.
10. Vendors are also encouraged to ensure that buyers, particularly "first timers", are advised either verbally or by a written hand-out, on general requirements for the care of the bird (s) purchased.
11. Thuringowa Bird Club Inc accepts no responsibility in any matter relating to loss or injury of any bird or product, or as to the condition of any bird or product sold.
12. Vendors are required to keep the Sales area tidy and ensure any rubbish etc is placed in the rubbish bins provided, prior to exiting the venue.
13. The Stewards reserve the right to interpret the above Sale Conditions at their discretion. In any dispute, the Stewards decision will be final and binding.
14. **Insurance:** Bird sellers must be a member of an insured club affiliated with the Canary and Caged Bird Federation of Australia Inc. Trade Seller must have their own business/public liability insurance and must produce a current copy to the club prior to the bird sale. Payment of the current membership fee or confirmation of current membership of an insured club affiliated with the CCBFA Inc is required.
15. **Permits to Display Licensed birds must be produced on arrival and must be visible throughout the period of the sale, licensed birds not listed on the permit will not be permitted entry to the Venue.**

Boxes should be based on show style boxes, enclosed on Three (3) sides, top & bottom. Perching for perching Species.

NB: As this year's sale is a Non Licensed Sale the following is a SAMPLE COPY only, of the information required by PALM to obtain a permit to display. Only Birds that require a License by the Vendor to sell need to be listed on the Permit, Vendors are not limited to 4 Licensed birds only please feel free to add more if you wish. Only birds listed on your permit will be permitted for display. Sale of these birds is not permitted on the premises or during the Sale.

The Location of Display Information is the correct information required for the Permit to Display.

A copy of the permit must be displayed by the vendor at the place the birds are being displayed. The bird must not have any visible signs of illness or injury, and must not be displayed for a commercial purpose.

At all times the birds considerations must be of the highest priority.

Please allow at least 5 working days for the process. Approved Display Permits will be emailed back to the individual requesting the permit and the original posted. If you do not have email capability bear in mind that normal mail does take quite considerably longer.
